Pray for our churches around the world as they celebrate the Chief Eldership of Christ in our Moravian churches around the world on November 13th.

Pray for the tens of thousands of refugees that are pouring into Europe and America trying to get away from war, drugs, and starvation. Pray for their safety, especially for women and children who are susceptible to being captured and sold into slavery. Pray for those countries receiving the refugees to find support for these people, especially the women and children, who have suffered so much, have lost so much and still have so many ordeals to face, before they can even begin to settle down in a safe place; we also need prayer support for all of those who are trying to help. "Pray for the many Moravian sisters in Germany are involved: distributing food and clothing, teaching German, playing with the children, even providing living quarters where possible. At the same time we are facing another difficult problem in that the growing numbers of refugees frighten many ordinary folks here and xenophobia is spreading quickly - all of us need prayer support to keep up our courage, to bear witness for our heavenly Father, who can take care of all our needs, while at the same time encouraging (and not condemning) the timid ones among us."

Continue to pray for our sisters and brothers in Nepal who continue to recover from the earthquake there. Now there has been another quake on the border of Afghanistan and Pakistan. Word has been received that this quake has also affected India so please keep our sisters and brothers in India in your prayers as well.

Pray for the 27 Moravian churches in the Czech Province. Also, pray for the church in Chrastava which is trying to open a new secondary school to prepare young people for work as social workers and teachers. The new school will be named after their former Bishop Jana Blahoslava. Pray that they will get the government approval to open this new school.

Let us give thanks for all the blessings that the Lord has bestowed on us. November 26th is celebrated as a national holiday (Thanksgiving Day) in America. Let us know if there are similar celebrations in your country and when they are held. Whatever the day is in your country, let us give thanks.

Pray for our sisters and brothers in Albania as they plan for their annual seminar to train existing and new leaders for the Moravian Church there. Also, pray for their ministry in the area of Bathore where they hope to minister to the physical needs of families, to start a support group for women who are victims of domestic violence, and to start an evangelization program there.

Pray for sisters Luise Schiewe from Niesky (Nurse) and Christiane Klingner from Königsfeld (Midwife) are going to spend some time between October and December 2015 at the Isoko Hospital, Tanzania, Southern Province.

Pray for the Women's Conference to be held in Temeke Congregation in Eastern Province of Tanzania from November 4-8, 2015. The purpose of the conference is to organize the Moravian women in Africa to join efforts by sharing experience on successes and challenges that women face in different aspects of their lives such as poverty, HIV/AIDS, education, violence against women and children. The theme is from Malachi 4:2a: "The Sun of Righteousness Shall Rise with Healing in Its Wings."
